# **Adjudicators**

#### Ms Philippa Paige

Bachelor of Music in Performance, Bachelor of Music in Performance University of Sydney

Philippa Paige has spent the last 30 years as a violinist with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra and as a member of the String Staff at the Sydney Conservatorium of Music. She studied with Robert Pikler in Sydney and with Bela Katona and Eli Goren in London where she worked as a free-lance player with a number of the London orchestras. As a teacher, Philippa's experience spans a wide variety of teaching contexts and covers levels from primary school age to post graduate. Her students have enjoyed considerable success and many now play professionally with leading orchestras in Australia and Europe and hold significant teaching positions. Violin pedagogy has always been a fascination and Philippa has researched widely and taught in this field throughout her career. For a number of years she served as String Advisor to the AMEB in NSW during which time she was one of the writers of the AMEB Violin Syllabus. Philippa presents master classes, lectures and workshops throughout Australia and internationally and appears frequently as adjudicator in music competitions. She has worked extensively as tutor and advisor to organisations such as the Sydney and Australian youth orchestras and as a mentor in the SSO Sinfonia and Fellowship Programmes.

#### Mr Evan Elsley B.A.

Examiner in String Instruments for the AMEB (NSW).

Violinist Evan Elsley, a university scholarship recipient, studied Violin at Sydney University and at the Sydney and Warsaw Conservatoriums. He has held Director of String positions in England, Australia and teaches at tertiary level. Evan is regularly asked to adjudicate Eisteddfods and conduct workshops. His students have won numerous scholarships, been awarded diplomas, degrees and have entered the profession. As a performer he works as a soloist and ensemble leader. His concert engagements for organisations including the ABC, Musica Viva, Sydney Festival, Conservatoriums and Arts Councils have received critical press acclaim. World premieres include works by major Australasian composers. Recordings have been on EMI, Festival, Larrikin, K Tel labels and his TV credits range through numerous midday and morning shows, ABC Music Specials, soaps, films. He has played in pop videos and commercials for both the local and international markets.

He has been booked to entertain other musicians and their promotional organisations, which include Elton John, Moscow Ballet, Australian Ballet, Royal Amsterdam, Melbourne and Sydney Symphony Orchestras.
